Installation Guide

1, When installing ensure the battens are left flush with the outer brickwork/barge board.



2, Install the Cromar Dry Fix Slate Verge directly on top of the battens allowing for a 50mm overhang at the eaves into the gutter and so not to obstruct the gutter the end of the Slate verge may need trimming underneath.





3, If the verge is more than 2 metre in length it is essential that a Cromar Slate Verge connector is used to join the two pieces and we recommend a small bead of clear waterproof sealant to the joint.





4, Once all the slate verge is installed start laying the slates ensuring that they are fixed into the overlap of the verge unit.
