Floor Defence Contract Hard Surface Protector

Description & Uses

AlphaChem, from Cromar, introduce Floor Defence a clear multi-purpose, contractors grade, self adhesive floor protector.

Ideal for providing a superior level of protection on all types of hard surfaces, including timber, hardwood, ceramic, vinyl, laminate, stone floors and worktops, from potentially expensive damage and spills – the perfect partner for any decorating, DIY or building work.

Floor Defence provides a safer alternative to dust sheets, which can be a trip hazard, and is easy to apply without the need for a special applicator. And being reverse wound the rolls are easy to apply, can be left down for up to 28 days, and are easily removed once a job is finished, leaving no adhesive residue behind.

- Protects against spills and damage
- Leaves no residue
- Reverse wound for ease of application
- No applicator required
- Easy to apply and remove
- 50 micron thickness

Directions

- Ensure all surfaces are clean, sound, dry and free from dust, oil, solvents or other chemicals.
- Simply unwrap the roll, pull out a short length and place (sticky side down) on the surface to protect.
- Unwind the roll, ensuring adhesion to the surface as you go, and cut off the product with a knife when the edge of the surface is reached.
- Take care to remove Floor Defence within 28 days of application.

Shelf Life

36 months from manufacture date.

Storage

Store indoors in cool, dry conditions +5 to +25°C.





Limitations

- Do not leave down from more than 28 days.
- Always test a small inconspicuous area for adhesion compatibility before large scale use.
- Not recommended for outdoor use.
- Adhesive is not water resistant.
- Do not use on substrates which bleed oils or plasticisers.
- Not suitable for use in areas where underfloor is in use.
- Not suitable for use on carpets and textiles, use AlphaChem Floor Defence Carpet Protector.
- On some surfaces a residue may be left, this can easily be removed using AlphaChem Grafters Wipes or a specialist hard surface cleaner.
- If applied in heavily trafficked areas or temperatures in excess of 22°C, remove after 1 week maximum.
- It is the user's responsibility to determine suitability for use.
